What's Involved?

- Providing a welcoming and inclusive home environment where the player feels comfortable.
- Offering a private bedroom and access to household facilities that are smoke-free.
- Providing meals in alignment with the dietary requirements of playing AFL football, while also encouraging the player's independence in cooking and household responsibilities over time.
- Supporting their adjustment to professional football, including structured training schedules and dietary requirements.
- Allowing the player access to utilities, including internet and washing machine facilities.

Support for Host Families

Financial assistance: Host families receive an allowance to help cover costs associated with housing a player, e.g., groceries, rent for the room, utilities etc.

Club support: Our Player Welfare team is available to assist with any concerns or questions.

Nutritional guidance: Our club dietitian provides recommendations to support the player's dietary needs.

Assistance with furnishing: If required, the club can help with necessary bedroom furniture.
